Did you know that Szczecin is the largest academic centre in West Pomerania? It is the place of operation for large public universities: Szczecin University, the Maritime University, the West Pomeranian University of Technology, the Pomeranian Medical University, the Academy of Arts, and many private universities. More than 35.000 students are educated in our city each year. Moreover, every year the interest in the offer of Szczecin universities is growing among people from other countries.



Majors related to the maritime industry are very popular. **The Maritime Academy** trains future officers, engineers and specialists in the transport or IT industry.



Computer science, automation and robotics are the most popular majors at the West Pomeranian **University of Technology**. The university also educates specialists in the chemical, construction and renewable energy industries.



The Pomeranian Medical University is also in Szczecin. The scientific activities of the university cover all fields of medical sciences, which is evidenced by the rich educational offer of 13 majors. Every year PUM is very high in rankings of the best Polish universities.



The largest university in the region is the **University of Szczecin**. Students gain knowledge in 7 departments and more than 80 majors. The range of possibilities is really wide - humanities, sciences, natural sciences, technical sciences and many more.



Study Art! This is the motto of the **Academy of Art**, which trains future graphic designers, musicians or architects. Szczecin's youngest public university is growing rapidly, creating new majors and attracting more and more applicants.

Prizes of the Mayor of Szczecin

The aim of the competition for the Prize of the Mayor of Szczecin for the best scientific paper is to promote innovative and original works related to Szczecin Development Strategy. In particular, the ones that promote original solutions that positively influence the development of the City and the region. Doctoral dissertations, master's theses, bachelor's theses, and engineering theses may all be submitted to the competition. All of them should present a high-level content and workshop and should concern topics related to such disciplines as science and life sciences, humanities and social sciences, engineering and technology, medicine or health sciences.

"Flats for Graduates" Program

"Flats for Graduates" is a housing program of the city implemented with Szczecin TBS (Communal Building Society). It is an attractive and less expensive form of living in Szczecin after graduation than a commercial one. It aims to support graduates of the most sought-after fields of study and people employed in Szczecin in sectors considered key by the city to its development. The scope of activities includes rental of comfortable and turnkey apartments on preferential terms. The program is also a guarantee of stable fees and being free from credit obligations.

"Flat for Students" Program

The "Flats for Students" program is a joint program of the City of Szczecin and Szczecin TBS. It is designed for the students of Szczecin universities permanently living outside Szczecin, and its aim is to create a friendly system of satisfying housing needs during studies. The designated rooms, located in the close vicinity of Szczecin universities, are fully adapted to the needs of students: the rooms have desks, beds, closets and chests of drawers. Kitchens and bathrooms are fully equipped. The rent in a student "M" is much lower than in the commercial real estate market. Lease agreements are for the entire period of study, with the possibility of early termination at the end of the academic year.

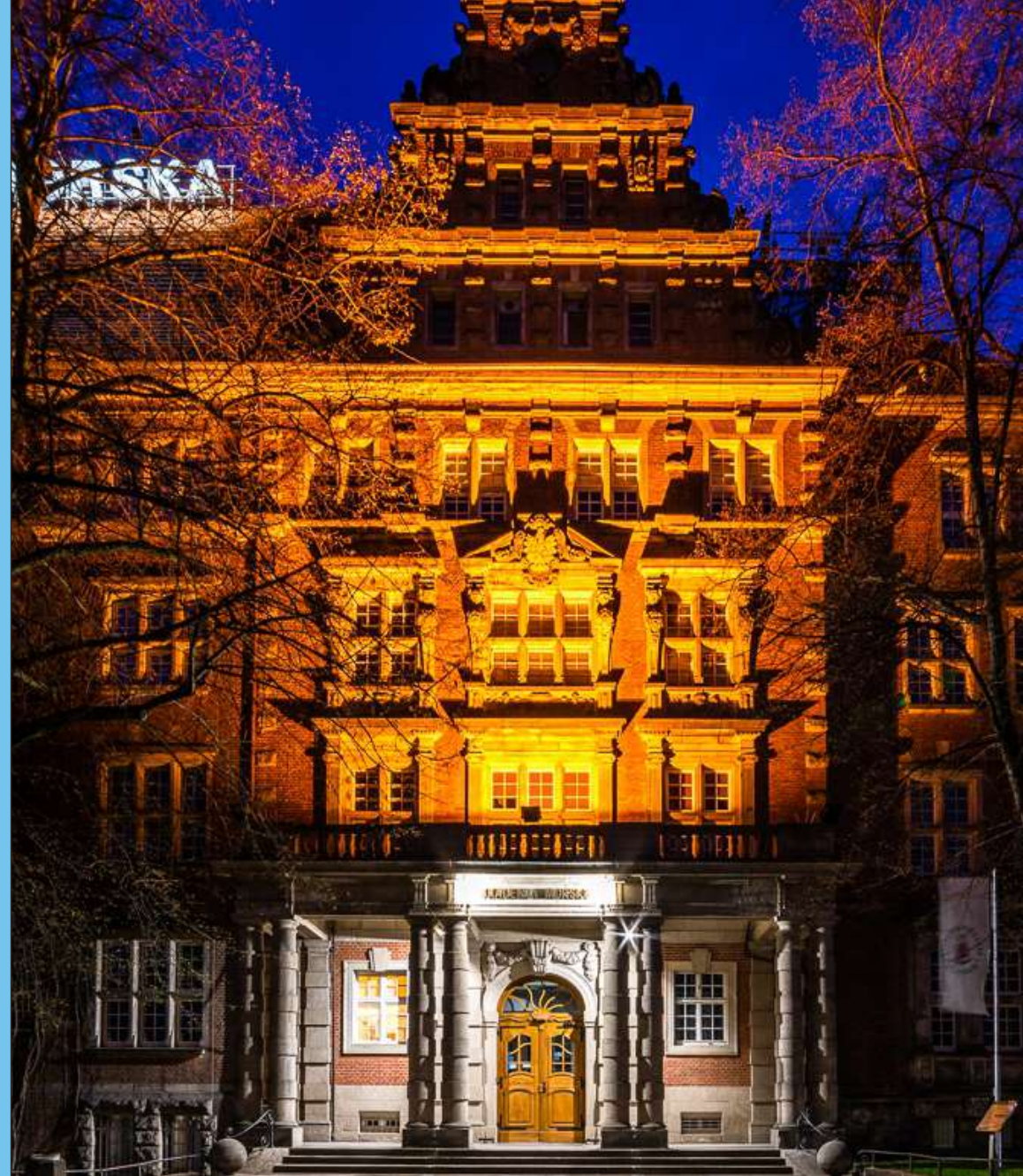

Pomeranian Medical University in Szczecin

The Pomeranian Medical University in Szczecin maintains a strong position among the top universities. Among nearly a hundred surveyed universities in Poland, we are ranked 16th in the TOP20. We are ranked high — in 4th place — among medical universities, and invariably first in the Zachodniopomorskie Voivodeship!

The PMU has 3 faculties: Medicine and Dentistry, Pharmacy, Medical Biotechnology and Laboratory Medicine, and Health Sciences. We offer majors in medicine, medicine and dentistry, medical analytics, pharmacy, medical biotechnology, clinical dietetics, physiotherapy, cosmetology, speech therapy with occupational therapy, nursing, midwifery, health psychology and health care system management, attended by more than five thousand students, including seven hundred under the English Programme and Asklepios Programme.

We run uniform master's studies, 1st and 2nd cycle studies, postgraduate studies and a doctoral school. Classes with students also take place at PMU's clinical hospitals: SPSK No. 1 at ul. Unii Lubelskiej and the hospital in Police, as well as the SPSK No. 2 in Szczecin's Pomorzany District, and the Medical Simulation Centre. The exams, on the other hand, are conducted in a state-of-the-art Test Exam Centre.

According to the PERSPEKTYWY ranking, PMU ranks high among public universities. As such, it is also worth highlighting its achievements in two specific categories of the ranking — "scientific effectiveness" and "publications" — where PMU ranked 2nd, as well as the "scientific potential" category, where it ranked 11th. Since general ratings classify universities irrespective of their specialisation, the ratings in specific fields of study should also be taken into account. Among medical universities, PMU ranked 1st in the "publications" category, 2nd in the "scientific effectiveness" and "scientific potential" categories and 4th in the "graduate on the labour market" category. The fields of study we offer remain highly popular. In the "medical and health-related fields of study" category, our cosmetology ranked 3rd, emergency medicine ranked 4th, medical ranked 6th, nursing and midwifery ranked 7th, medical and dental ranked 8th, pharmacy and medical analytics ranked 11th, biotechnology ranked 12th and physiotherapy ranked 17th. In 2022, 73 groups in nine scientific fields were assessed.

The Doctoral School of the University of Szczecin offers multidirectional preparation of young scientists to function independently in the domestic and foreign scientific environment. Its comprehensive curriculum enables the high development of research skills.

The US Doctoral School provides training in the following fields of science:

- humanities (discipline: philosophy, history, linguistics, literary studies),
- medical and health sciences (discipline: physical education sciences),
- social sciences (discipline: economics and finance, socio-economic geography and spatial management, political and administrative sciences, management and quality sciences, legal sciences, education)
- physical, mathematical and natural sciences (discipline: mathematics, biological sciences, physical sciences, Earth sciences and environmental sciences),
- theological sciences,
- interdisciplinary education — doctoral students indicate their primary discipline of choice and another one if their dissertation is at the threshold of two disciplines.

Each doctoral student receives a grant of about PLN 2,050 during the first two years of training, and then after a positive mid-term evaluation, about PLN 3,150. Doctoral students with disabilities receive an additional PLN 700.

The Doctoral School of the University of Szczecin also provides implementation doctorates under a project of the Ministry of Education and Science.
